When to Visit an Emergency Department:

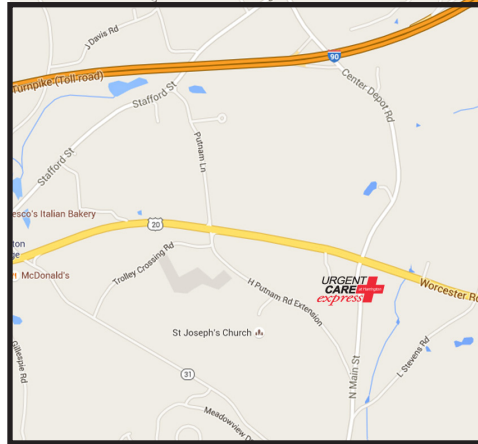
- Coughing or vomiting blood

- Suicidal or homicidal feelings
- Uncontrollable pain or bleeding

- Flu-like symptoms
- Headaches/migraines
- Minor burns or lacerations
- Minor strains or sprains
- Rashes, skin, and eye infections
- Sinus infections
- Stomach pain, nausea, diarrhea, or vomiting
- Urinary tract infections
